Currently using Dublin Core. Only goes to finding things in an on-line environment (card catalog).

Demo of the on-line catalog. Using In-Magic/DBText works - Pulled up records of Framework example.

Demo died of course.

Unified catalog - Big Back End. Finding tool for what we have on hand.

Currently using this for Kolsky and other collections. Has about 5000 records today.

Some fields being overloaded to apply to different collections (software, images, etc.) and some fields unique to particular collection.

In conjunction with defining fields also defining controlled vocabulary. Will draw from existing standards. Where one doesn't exist then will need to create a controlled vocabulary.

Some discussion on limitations of the Inmagic system and how will be used in long term. Inmagic stores data in proprietary database, but very chep tool and usable today.

More discussion about what to use in the long term.

Status of Meta Data

Want to get to preservation meta-data. Reviewed Premis information, and heads up on upcoming information from this group.
