
Objectives

- ~65,600 files (2.8 Gb) in 2665 folders (36 top-level) received from U. Arizona (Griswold & Townsend) September 2006
- Test Win/XP installation of Greenstone Digital Library working. Good for learning, but not an adequate service environment.
